Amanda McLean is a highly-regarded artist who has been exhibiting for around 30 years and teaching for over 20 years. She has been a regular contributor to Australian Artist and International Artist Magazine for many years. Her broad knowledge of the pastel medium has seen her contribute to developing paper and Pastel colours, and to test new products under development. This includes a new range of Australian pastels due for release in 2017. She is recognised for her sensitive interpretations of the local landscape especially her skies and water.
