## Workshop Description

Working in an abstract way from the imagination to start with, participants will experience total freedom in mark making, use of colour, texture and materials. Once this feeling of freedom is established, still life objects will be introduced.

Freedom to explore will be encouraged. Detail will not be an issue at first, instead, "take a line for a walk". Discovery will come from experimentation. One aim is to become familiar with the still life objects and feel uninhibited in referring to them in drawing and painting. The other aim is to feel free to create images, which in themselves work in an abstract way and do not necessarily refer directly to any known subject matter.

Acrylic paint will be the main medium used but drawing, collaging, splashing, scraping, etc, and using any other materials will be encouraged.

## About Peter

Born in Adelaide, Peter now works as a full time artist in his Sydney studio. He enjoys painting en plein air in various parts of the world, especially in the outback of Australia.

For the past 45 years he has exhibited in over 50 solo showings throughout Australia, and more in London, Paris, St.Tropez, Lyon and New Zealand. His works have been shown in art fairs in Europe, Canada and Asia, and he exhibits widely in group exhibitions. His commissioned and non-commissioned work has been acquired for private, public and corporate collections in Australia and overseas. Peter is represented by galleries throughout Australia and in Copenhagen, and by agents in UK and France.
