Learning the fundamentals is the key to unrevealing the magic of this illusive medium. This well-structured course with many demonstrations, hands-on exercises and good guidance; will allow the student to gain a wider understanding of the medium of watercolour, which will help them build their confidence to express with greater freedom.

The students will complete a small simple painting each week based to the techniques demonstrated. This class will be led by master watercolourist Chan Dissanayake, who is highly knowledgeable teacher in the field of watercolour.

- Week 7 - Understanding Perspective & Proportions
- Week 8 - Planning and Composition
