This course is designed to suit a student who has some or limited experience in watercolour; and wants to extend their knowledge to the next level.

The course is aimed at extending the knowledge of watercolour techniques studied in **Module 1: Watercolour Fundamentals** and gain a deeper understanding of concepts that they already know. The classes are supported with demonstrations and instruction which

are then followed by the students working on their own piece.

The true magic of watercolour lies in understanding the wet-into-wet technique. This course will offer opportunities in judging the wetness of the paper and which consistencies of water to paint ratios are need to produce the desired magical effects. It is then the real learning and personal growth can truly begin. This class will be led by master watercolourist Chan Dissanayake, who is highly knowledgeable teacher and a well-regarded artist in the field of watercolour.
