Robyn has also taken part in many 'Artist in Residence' programs both on the mainland and on many of Australia's remote islands and is considered a contemporary realist, painting our wilderness in its many and varied aspects. She is a keen bushwalker and walks many kilometres to find the subjects of her choice – preferably in remote areas. Robyn is a member of the Guild of Realist Artists, Society of Mountain Artists, Springwood Bushwalkers and the Blue Mountains Conservation Society and is a passionate environmentalist.
