EXPERIMENTAL MARK MAKING with HAND MADE BRUSHES Lorna Crane > Tutor

Materials List

Brush Making

Handles include

- > driftwood, bamboo, sticks, deconstructed pre loved brushes or found objects
- > scissors
- > PVA glue
- > electrical tape (3M can be purchased from hardware stores)

Mark Making

- > Black Ink 500ml Art Spectrum, Speedball, Chromacryl or Chinese ink (you can bring additional coloured inks if you like to add but black ink is essential)
- > Small bowls to dip into ink
- > Containers to dilute ink and for water rinse ups
- > Bucket
- > Sponges / dishcloth for clean up
- > Paper - assorted sheets and old works for over drawing in ink
- > Found papers, old book pages etc for collage
- > A3 size pad of paper at least 150gsm
- > acrylic paint - your choice of colours
- > Apron
- > Tablecloth or plastic covering for workspace
- > some of your favourite brushes including a 5cm wide brush
- > pencils, crayons or markers
- > Glue sticks
- > Scrapers
- > small metal ruler

I will be bring extra materials for the binding of the brushes plus extra paper that may be harder to source
